Trap Falls Kennel Club for partnering with the United States Tennis Association to provide supplies to a military canine unit stationed in Afghanistan. USTA Military Outreach shared the following on their Facebook:

The 3rd Combat Engineer Battalion Canine Unit stationed in Afghanistan is the beneficiary of a unique partnership that is bringing supplies to both the troops and their canine partners to help make their lives easier and to provide needed recreation. The Trap Falls Kennel Club (TFKC) of Connecticut "adopted" the canine unit and sent boxes of supplies for the troops, including items to help care for the approximately 70 dogs. Next, the U.S. Tennis Association, through its "Adopt-A-Unit" effort, will send portable tennis equipment to the unit's soldiers to help provide recreation. TFKC is the first kennel club in the country through the American Kennel Club (AKC) to team up with the USTA in participating in the USTA's "Adopt-A-Unit" program to provide tennis to the troops. "Since so many dogs are serving in the military alongside their human troops, it seemed like a good idea to expand the reach of giving to a canine unit, and what better group to initiate that than an AKC-sponsored club," organizer Cindy Sherman said.
