Go approx ½ mile and take a left on Field St. (Irving Gas station is on the corner before Field street and Hop Brook Golf Course is across the street.) #### Trap Falls Adopt-A-Unit Program

Trap Falls Kennel Club has partnered with the U.S. Tennis Association (USTA) in adopting a Military Unit overseas. Trap Falls will be the first kennel club to pilot this program with the USTA. The AKC has welcomed the opportunity for us to participate with the USTA since this will forge a new relationship with an outside organization, creating firsts for each group, along with great publicity.

We have tailored the program so that we will be supporting Canine Units. Specifically, Trap Falls will be sending supplies to a Canine Unit (Marines) based in Afghanistan.

We have communicated with the Staff Sergeant there who has expressed his troops' gratitude for our help. Once we have sent supplies to this unit, the USTA will send them portable tennis equipment. The idea is to introduce soldiers who don't already play tennis, a means of sport and recreation. When returning to their community, they have the opportunity to integrate the sport into their lives.
